

Destination Imagination

Meeting 1: November 27, 2007

1. Nametags upon entering. Refreshments in kitchen.
2. Welcome: A few words about DI and what we will do (everyone sit in the family room).

Basic Rules to kids:

- a. Behave as you would in school
 - b. Listen to everyone's ideas
 - c. Be kind to your teammates
 - d. All work must be done only by the team: Interference (to parents also, will talk more later)
3. Everyone introduces themselves. Say name, grade, why you decided to do DI, and your favorite thing to do.
 4. Kids choose their folders. Let's figure out how to do this.
 5. Kids give folders to parent(s). Parents go to kitchen and chat for a few minutes.
 6. Paul and Maureen get kids started on their first challenge (building blocks). How high can you build the tower? Work together. Measure height. Keep trying. Maureen stays with kids. No Interference.
 7. Paul discusses with parents in kitchen. Go over folders.
 8. When both are finished, everyone goes back to family room and we discuss the block challenge. How high did you make the tower? What did you do to make it taller? Did you work together? Did everyone get a chance to put blocks on? Is there anything you could have done to make the tower taller? Congratulate them on good work.
 9. Next challenge: Without talking put the DI team in order by age from youngest to oldest.
 10. Inform them of their homework (Self-Analysis & Contract).
